| Arapahoe | Meet as a community to discuss a plan to end homelessness | -Begin community conversation -Create a plan -Emergency/cold weather shelter | Meet as a group under the leadership of Family Tree |
| Aurora | Continue developing homeless plan | -Children and working family homelessness | Convene leadership group and then convene an advisory group |
| Boulder | Community awareness and engagement | -Offender re-entry -Addiction treatment | Garner community support and political will |
| Broomfield | Community and political awareness | -Housing issues | Partner with other agencies and counties |
| Denver | Housing development | -Lack of affordable housing -Lack of emergency shelter | Work on housing component of 10 year plan |
| Douglas | Housing development, including scattered site options for transitional housing | -Transportation -Transitional Housing -Cold weather shelter | Fully develop a homeless plan |
| Jefferson | Emergency shelter/severe weather options (including motels and vouchers) | -Affordable housing -Offender re-entry | Fully develop a homeless plan |

Suggestions for Crossover among Metro Area Cities and Counties

Convene Human Service directors and CDBG administrators from each county to develop a shared pool of funds to be used for a region-wide project

Douglas County to provide technical assistance to Aurora for the Aurora at Home plan

Boulder to work with Broomfield to develop community awareness and garner political will in their area

Metro-wide severe weather response planning and connectivity

State/county/city corrections release coordination

Metro-wide Fire and Police homeless awareness training

Metro-wide dispatch service to mobilize appropriate emergency responders
